



Wildland Special Use Policy

Adopted 2007, Revised 2018

GPMCT welcomes groups to use the recreational trails in the Wildlands, according to the trust's guidelines and regulations. We appreciate knowing when your group will use the property, but don't require prior permission unless:

- Your group size will be over 15 people
- You are camping
- You'll be bringing more than 5 vehicles and/or trailers into the property
- You are requesting special access

The following rules apply when a group requests special access to the Wildlands, e.g. being let into the gate or taking vehicles past a barricade, or requesting staff or volunteer assistance:

- GPMCT reserves the right to deny any request for special access. Access will only be granted for activities that fall under the Trust's guidelines and do not negatively impact the property's conservation or recreation values.
- Groups requesting special access will pay a minimum \$50 fee to GPMCT to offset costs of managing groups on the Wildlands. In limited cases, volunteer work, approved ahead of time, can be performed in lieu of fee
- Camping with groups over 15 requires bringing in Porta Potties, etc. which have an additional cost
- For education or scientific groups, we request results of the event when appropriate, such as lists of birds, mushrooms, insects seen, etc.
